1. Authority

1.1 Under the By-Laws of the Faculty and Staff Association, the Directors may designate any group of employees as eligible to have a Technology Representative. To promote communication with FSA members in Part-Time Studies, the President is delegated the authority to designate a group of PTS Instructors as an eligible group for the purpose of being represented by a Technology Representative. Normally, the group should be reflective of the Day School Departmental structure.

2. Process of Election

2.1 The President may appoint an Interim Tech Rep for a designated group of PTS Instructors, for a period of up to two months. The appointment may be renewed if the election process has not been completed within the period.

2.2 The responsibility of the Interim Tech Rep is to facilitate the development of a process for the election of a Tech Rep for the approved group. The electoral process must be acceptable to the President.

2.3 Oversight of the election process is delegated to the President.

2.4 The term of office for a PTS Tech Rep shall be from October 1st - September 30th.

2.5 A duly elected PTS Tech Rep who ceases to become employed by BCIT shall be eligible to continue in office for a bridging period of up to five months. If not reappointed as a PTS Instructor within that period, a new PTS Tech Rep shall be elected as directed by the President.

3. Rights of Interim and elected PTS Tech Reps

3.1 Interim and elected PTS Tech Reps shall have the same rights and responsibilities as Day School Tech Reps.
